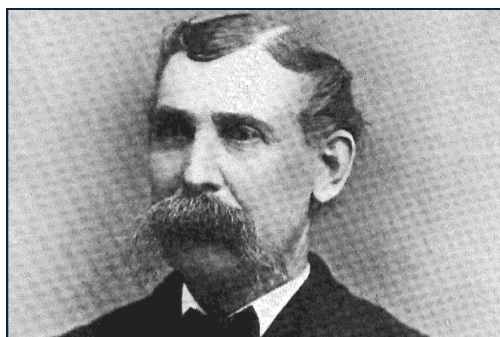


# Beebe Boat Yard: Its History & Surf Boats
