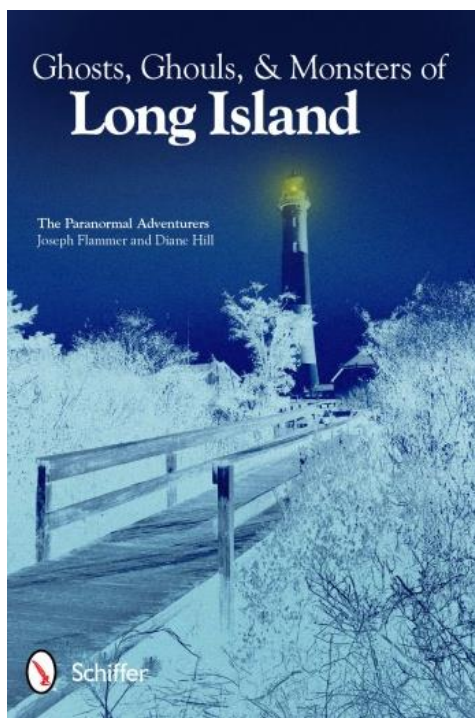


# Ghosts, Ghouls, & Monsters of Long Island
