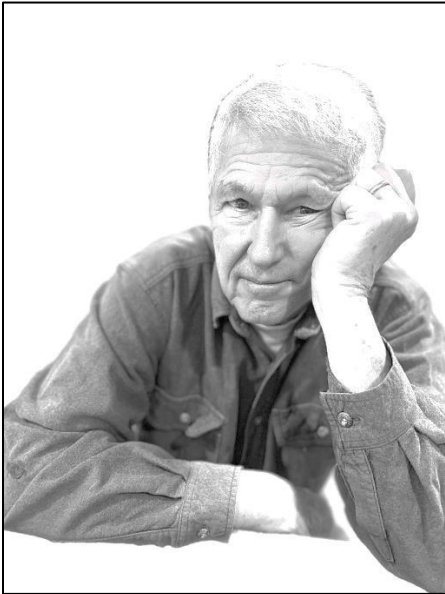


History of Duck Decoys of Long Island
