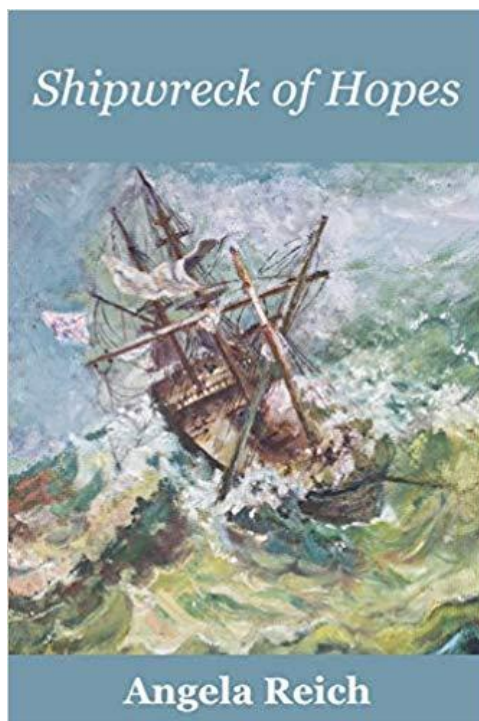


Shipwreck of Hopes

Please join us as we welcome Angela Reich - author, docent and sailor - to explore her first novel, *Shipwreck of Hopes*. As a researcher, Reich has shared her knowledge of Long Island's maritime history; lecturing for Fire Island National Seashore as well as various LI historical societies. A Ph.D in literature, Reich has published articles on literary criticism in professional journals and a book on John Milton's *Paradise Regained*.



Reich's *Shipwreck of Hopes* sweeps the reader from a desolate beach in New York to war torn Italy to tell a story of shipwreck, thievery, and murder.

Drawing inventively on the lives that converged with the fate of the ship *Elizabeth* in 1850, Reich goes beyond biography to reveal the harrowing journeys of those involved on that desperate day.

Reich reconciles the famous and brilliant Margaret Fuller with simple and humble Hannah Oaks; two women who risk everything in their quests to take back their own lives.
