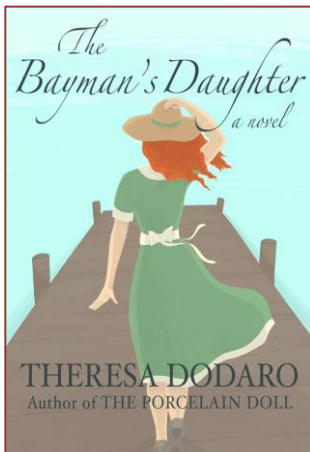


The Bayman's Daughter
